Dress Code & Camp Rules

Please discuss these rules with sponsors & campers at least 2 weeks prior to camp.

Dress-up Time

Clothing worn during Worship Services should be modest & clean in appearance.

Recreation Time

Recreation clothing must be knee length & modest in appearance.

No Clothing Should Be

Skin tight, see-through, “skimpy,” suggestive, or show advertising of anyone or anything which suggests an unchristian lifestyle or activity.

No PDA (Public Display of Affection)

1. Campers will not be allowed to engage in an open display of physical affection.
2. Campers must stay in well-lit areas after dark.
3. Campers must stay within the physical boundaries of the camp facility at all times unless permission is granted to leave. Even if you are a sponsor, please let one of the Camp Directors know before leaving the camp grounds. This enables us to make contact in the case of an emergency.

Because of the close quarters sleeping & general hygiene, if head lice are found at camp, camper will be sent home.

1. All rules must be adhered to by all campers at all times.
2. Campers 12 years & under may receive leniency on dress code, but caution for modesty always.
3. Final authority and ruling will come from Encampment Committee for any individual who must be cautioned about his/her conduct or clothing. The Encampment Committee has the authority to send non-compliant campers home.

Age Requirements

CHILDREN'S CAMP is designed for campers age 8 to those who have completed 5th grade. Those who are 7 and under **MUST** be accompanied by a same gender parent. Little boys 4 and under will be allowed to stay with their mothers in the dorm.

TEEN CAMP for campers who have completed 6th grade and above. We realize that situations may arise where you have no option, however if possible, please do not bring children 5th grade & younger to Teen Camp.

Camp Fees (T-Shirt Included for each Registration)

Children's Camp July 21st – 24th: We will leave Bethel at 3:30 pm on July 21st

- \$45.00 – 8 years old to 5th grade
- \$30.00 – 7 years old and under
- \$35.00 – Sponsor

Teen Camp July 24th – 27th. We will leave Bethel at 3:30 pm on July 24th

- \$55.00 – 6th – 12th grade
- \$35.00 – 5th grade and under for those that must come with parents.
- \$35.00 – Sponsors

RV Campers (Those sleeping in RVs will pay the same camp fees.)

Notice to RV Campers

The Encampment Committee prefers that you do not bring RVs to the Meramec Retreat Center prior to Saturday, July 13th due to mowing, etc. The Encampment Committee and Meramec Retreat Center will not be responsible for damages. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Medical Release Forms

All campers are required to have a Medical Release Form signed by a parent or legal guardian. The release form also includes a rules and dress code agreement. The Medical Release Form contained in this packet may be copied and used for this purpose. ***The release form for transportation to and from the water park must be filled out by parent or guardian. Anyone not having this form filled out will have to stay at camp.***

Water Park Recreation

Both camps will make 1 trip to the Water Park in Sullivan. Understanding the need for modesty, we ask that all those attending camp from Bethel wear a shirt with their suit.

Things to Bring

1. Bible, paper and pencil for worship service
2. Sheets for twin size bed or sleeping bag, pillow and blanket. The rooms are air-conditioned, so if you are cold natured, bring appropriate bedding.
3. Personal items such as towels, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, baseball glove, Frisbee, etc.
4. Campers will need clothes for worship time and recreation time. Please bring clothes for recreation time that you do not mind getting **very dirty and are not revealing when wet**. Our recreation time may include water games.
5. Snacks and/or money for snack shack

Things to leave at home

1. **All electronic devices** including but not limited to Phones, MP3 Players, video games. This is the only Bethel youth event where we limit electronics. We want this to be a retreat!
2. This is a tobacco- and smoke-free campus. Please leave all products at home.
