Cost "Registration Fee"

The cost of the conference this year will be **\$70.00 per person**. This includes a \$55.00 registration fee and \$15.00 towards your hotel room. Obviously, your hotel room for 2 nights cost more than \$15.00. The Youth budget will cover the rest of the room. Thank you, Bethel Church!! This registration fee is **non – refundable**. The "non – refundable" refers to the registration fee for persons that are registered for the conference and then for whatever reason do not come to the conference. If inclement weather or something to that extent does not allow us to have a conference, we will refund all the registration fees back.

This **\$70.00** per person includes everything that is offered at the Alive Student Conference except for the meals and anything the students want to buy for themselves. We will be eating out 4 times during the conference. You will need to bring enough money "depending on how much you eat" to cover the 4 meals at fast food type restaurants. If you are a big breakfast person you can eat breakfast at the hotel, but this is optional and usually expensive. I would recommend just bringing some breakfast bars. We will also probably be going somewhere like a mall during some free time on the second day so if you would like to buy something there you will obviously need you own money for that.

If finances are keeping you from going to the conference, please come talk to me. We have individuals that sponsor students and a youth budget that will allow you to go.

Medical Release Form

Every student **must** turn in a medical release form to me, "Brad," before you are considered registered for the conference.

Deadline

The deadline for returning your registration fee and medical release form is **December 1, 2019**. You can register after this time, but it is greatly discouraged. The reasons are that you will not get a conference t-shirt and it also just creates a huge logistics headache for me on transportation and number of sponsors going. **Please register as early as possible if you are going to the conference.**

Timeline for leaving and returning

We will meet at the church at 4:00 p.m. on December 29th and we will return on December 31st at approx. 2:00 p.m. If you are picking your student up on the 31st, a call will be placed to you while eating lunch on the approx. time we will arrive at church so that neither party will have to wait very long if the schedule gets adjusted beyond our control.
